New mall in Chino Hills getting Trader Joe's, Pinkberry, H&M, more

Trader Joe's, Pinkberry and H&M are among about 65 retailers coming to The Shoppes at Chino Hills, set to open in late May.

The majority of the retailers and restaurants will open at the outdoor shopping center on May 23. The center, at Grand Avenue and Peyton Drive just west of the Chino Valley Freeway, is 91 percent leased.

At 400,000 square feet, it's similar in size to Anaheim Garden-

Walk, which is holding its grand opening also in late May.

The Shoppes will be surrounded by 240 units of luxury housing and will include 50,000 square feet of office space built over the retail.

Among other retailers that have signed leases are Aeropostale, American Eagle, Ann Taylor Loft, Banana Republic, Bella's Boutique, Coldwater Creek, Hollister, PacSun and Vans.

Among restaurants that have signed leases are California Pizza Kitchen, Chipotle, Johnny Rockets, Panera Bread, Pinkberry, PF Chang's China Bistro and Yard House Bar & Grill.
